

Primary Sports Grant

The Government is providing additional funding to Primary schools to improve physical education (PE). This funding is split over 3 financial years.

Schools can choose how they use the funding but examples would be to:

- hire specialist PE teachers or qualified sports coaches
- support and involve the least active children by running after-school sports clubs and holiday clubs
- provide resources and training courses in PE and sport for teachers
- run sports activities with other schools
